10. BRIEF SUMMARY OF SIGHTING

Sighting in morn by 13 yr old boy of obj about 100 ft in diameter, round smooth or oval shape at alt of 100-160 yds exhibiting speeds of 100 mph to 1,000 mph. Direction of flight to North. Maneuvers included standing still, straight up, and sideways. Color was red like a ball of flame. No sound. Duration was 1/1/2mins coming down (approaching) 27 secs hovering & three secs going away. Sky conditions fog.

Duration indicates aircraft sighting. Ball of flame indicates jet w/afterburner or possible meteor; however, sighting at dawn & brightness not indicated. No mention of how time figured. 27 sec hovering not consistent with a/c analysis. Alt of 100 yd extremely low. Detail should have been noted during hovering. Sound should have been audible at such low level. Conflicting data- unreliable rpt.
