At this time we do not have any plans which would include their use, so we are returning them to you.







ow color This "sighting" happened on April 25,1966 at about 8- 82 peme Several at the suppor table talked about "sightings" and asked me what I thought about it? They said that nobedy knows exactly what it is. Real or imaginary?-"Some may be hallucinating or somehow confused by various problems. If I would only see one myself I am sure I could tell you what it is," I remarked not lacking in security "Oh, if I could only see one! I wish so badly to meet one personally . and best from face to face!" And imagine about 3 hours later it happened really! And it was face to face tor ! I was sitting in my physician's apartment closely facing the foot rails of my bed. I was reading the newspaper foreign news with nothing in it about "sightings". I sat near the window but had no intention to look out through it. But suddenly I turned around and incidentally I looked out through the window. And there it was! And so close to me! I felt I could touch it. It was like a friend looking into my eyes. It was standing still hovering just in front of me and slightly above me. It was a huge circular thing of brightest green celer slightly mingled with blue. It was fibrillating with silver dots. Like a wheel it had spikes of extremely fine structure. Gradually 3 or 4 circles appeared in an area that was moving clockwise, very slowly moving. Suddenly it seemed it was moving closer to me with its center division and after a while it retracted again. It made me think of an eld fashioned camera I was startled fascinated by that most intense bluish green silvery celer so bright and intense I never saw before. This must be a thing of most advanced technology I thought and I wished it would never be used for War. Did it last longer than one second? I was so impressed I did not look for watch nor clock.

## Like my "UFO"?

When that center part had been retracted the whole thing turned abruptly to its right side. It proceeded slowly in a straight herizontal line and thus it expessed its whole body. It resembled an airplane but without wings. I noticed pert heles like in a steambeat about a dozen of them and through the last 5 or 6 port holes a short black pipe was protruding. The general color was brownish blue. The black pipe endings spew huge erange-red flames and lofty smeke. The tail end was on fire with huge paths of it charred to coal and and threatening to fall down."It just should not fall down on us and set this building on fire!"I thought. There was no noise and no heat. As it resembled a jet plane my next thought was:"This cannot be a machine only. There must be or may be a pilet in it! Why didn't I wink him? I should have winked him to make him eject. He may not be aware that his tail is on fire!! And I felt sorry that I "forget" to wink him ---- Perhaps a few seconds later after awakening from this rare episode I hurried to the other side of the building to check on his burning tail hoping he is still alive-But there was nothing exactly nothing to be seen. It was darkest reyal blue as far as my eyes could reach. No flames anymore. No smoke. Ne Seneca Lake to be seen, no waves, no trees, no Dresden shere, no clouds -- just nothing to be seen."This must be a blackeut" I thought.

But what did happen to "him"?

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

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
