Dear Allen,

Yes, I was sorry we did not get together, as I would very much like to share my UFO esperiences with you especially upon the recommendations of Dr. Otto. Your knowledge and understanding of this sensational phenomenon, unlike most people's, Ifeel would comprehend it.

Since my travels do include all the places you mentioned, Marinette would be the nearest for you and easily planned on my agenda. I could meet you there upon a couple of days notice. I will bring along a recorded cartridge of my experiences which I can comment on. This will make it pre-organized and ready. I could meet with you next week, say Wednesday or Thursday, September the 4th or 5th. A good meeting place would be the lobby of the St.Joseph Lloyd's Mospital at Menominee.

My wife, daughter and I had our first sighting on August 28, 1967 at 12:45 a.m. After leaving a dinner engagement with Dr. Jones and wife at Menominee and traveling about 150 miles to Lake Gogebic on U.S. Hwy. #2, I noticed seven very bright orange lights amongst the stars. I first took them for stars but noticed the unusual V formation. No sooner had I questioned myself, could these be UFOs, they responded with speed faster than the eyesight and hovered over the trees alongside the road and my car. Underneath each one was a round floodlight which blinded our vision. At this point, I shook my wife and daughter and they practically went into shock upon sight of them. They kept hovering by the road over a gravel pit and some high tension wires, as if they wanted to communicate with us. My wife and daughter would not let me get out of the car, so we observed them for about five minutes from the car. About then, another car arrived on the seen and stopped, so I left upon the pleas of my family. We had three sightings after that in about the same area and way, two during the latter part of June, 1968 and one on August 17th at the same time of Il:27 p.m.
