

ENGLAND: March 31, 1968 - "GHOST TRAIN IN THE SKY" - Police are sending a report to the Ministry of Defence this weekend giving details of an unidentified flying object seen by two officers in a squad car. It was spotted as the police crew were driving in Union Street, Torquay, Devon, about 3:15 AM on Thurdday. Supt. Harry Brooks, head of Torquay police, said yesterday: "This is something that can ot be dismissed out ofhand. The officers, patrolmen Michael Kirby and Basil Warren, are very reliable and we questioned them closely. "They describe the object as being very like a railway carriage travelling across the sky and estimate that it was flying at about 150 ft. A line of illuminated portholes down one side was clearly visible. "The officers also say it was only in view for a few seconds, but was considerably lagger than a Vulcan bomber." ...
