Dear Sirs:

I was called this morning by a close friend of mine who related the following sighting to me. I got as many details as possible then went over to his house and got the enclosed drawing he made.

Date: June 28, 1969 Time: 10:30-10:45 PM Location: Tarrant County, between Dallas & Ft. Worth, Texas; approx. 1 mile northeast of the intersection of highways 114 and Beltline Rd. Sky: clear with stars Wind: 2-4 MPH. Occurance follows:

An object was first noted about 10:30 PM CDST southeast 60 to 75 degrees above the horizon. The object was about the size of a dime held at arms length. The object had a red flashing light on the top. Below the red light were a horizontal row of white lights flashing from left to right in sequence. It gave the impression of either sequential flashing, or a dark area revolving across the lighted parts (or windows). Altitude unknown(witness guessed about 2,000 ft.) He estimated speed between 75 and 90 miles per hour. Northeast of where the witness was was some ground spot lights moving around the sky. The object came from the southeast and moved to the northeast. It made two circles toward the direction of the spotlights then moved off in a southeasterly direction over a hilltop waxxw and was out of sight at 10:45 PM. The objects speed did not vary during the sighting. There was no sound at any time. At one time when the object was at a great distance away, he saw a green light. The shape was not discernable with the naked eye. He did have a pair of 7x35 binoculars which he showed me. with them, and the object at a proximity the sixe was between a quarter and a half dollar at arms length. Through the binoculars he clearly made out the object as a disc shape. The witnesses! name is Byron Kirkwood, a neighbor of mine who gives his permission for you to use his name if you wish. He is also signing this report.

Enclosed are copies of my documentation of two UFO siteings that you requested I send you when I met you in Dallas.


The single sheet dated October 25,1957 was described to me by my grandmother the morning after her siteing. She described it as a mother ship and three smaller baby ships.

Sequence of Events

Saturday nite of June 28, 1969 my wife and Q were Camping out at North Lake, in Tarrant County (Texas). at approximately 10:30 I war a noticed an abject that at first glance appeared to be a small aircraft. It was moning to moved at approximately the same speed and alleticle of a light plane, and had a rotating red light. The only thing wrong was "it had too many white lights". at first I thought it might be londing lights, then it appeared to be windows.

at this time I yelled to my wife to look, and I started feembling for my tincolars. Often getting the lenses covers and the sun filters off of raised the bincolors and looked. At this point & sealing that saw the UFO and realized that it was not a conventional aircraft, and that it was a "flying souser.". It looked storest like something out of the Sueaders". When I saw it through the benoud, it had already passed over us and was moving away toward the west. over the horizon at 10:45.


Description

1. The UFO was Dish spaped with white lights or windows around the perimeter. De had a bright sed rotating (or flushing) become on top.

2. The white lights had it least one dark spot that rotated around or sequenced around the ship at an estimated one revocultion per second.

3. The craft There was no noticable noise of any kind emitted from the auft.

4. The UFO moved at an estimated 75 to 100 miles on hours at approximately a crude guess to the altitude would be 2000 ft.
