Dear Sirs,

I have read the little magazine "Flying Saucers" it is the way I have got your address.

I don't know if the informations I have will help you very much, because it happened in the beginning of May 1953.

I was in Canada only since few days and I didn't want to be taken for a fool by the people here, so I kept it for me.

After what I have read until now about UFO, I thing the one I saw was different.

I was in Montreal near the river, about 2 o'clock in the afternoon, the sky was very clear, almost no clouds and bright sun.

It was about at 400 yards and at about 150 yards from the ground. motionless, then it went down until 60 yards and it stayed motionless during about 30 seconds. it went back higher and disappeared at full speed.

I have been surprised by its size. It was at least 40 yards of diameter and 4 yards high. The color was sand beach and it was no flames or blue light around it; even when it took high speed it was no sign of flame or blue light as the people said about flying saucer. it was surprising fast how it could pass from motionless to high speed.

In 1947 I have seen the english jet Gloucester Meteor in full speed; I don't thing I exaggerate if I tell you the speed was about four times the one of these Gloucester meteors, it disappeared at the horizon in few seconds.

The shape was also different from the pictures I have seen in this magazine. On the top were some holes scuttles I imagined. I have made a little sketch showing the approximative shape. The ufo was completely silent and it was no clue that could make you guess which kind of power it used.

If by random you could be interested about this, don't write to me, I have given all I knew. I only wrote it because what I have seen was different.
