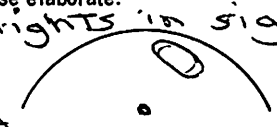

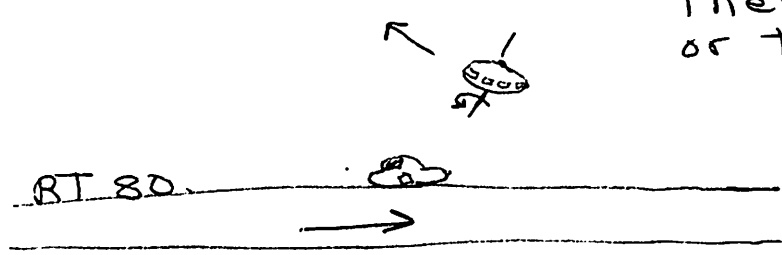

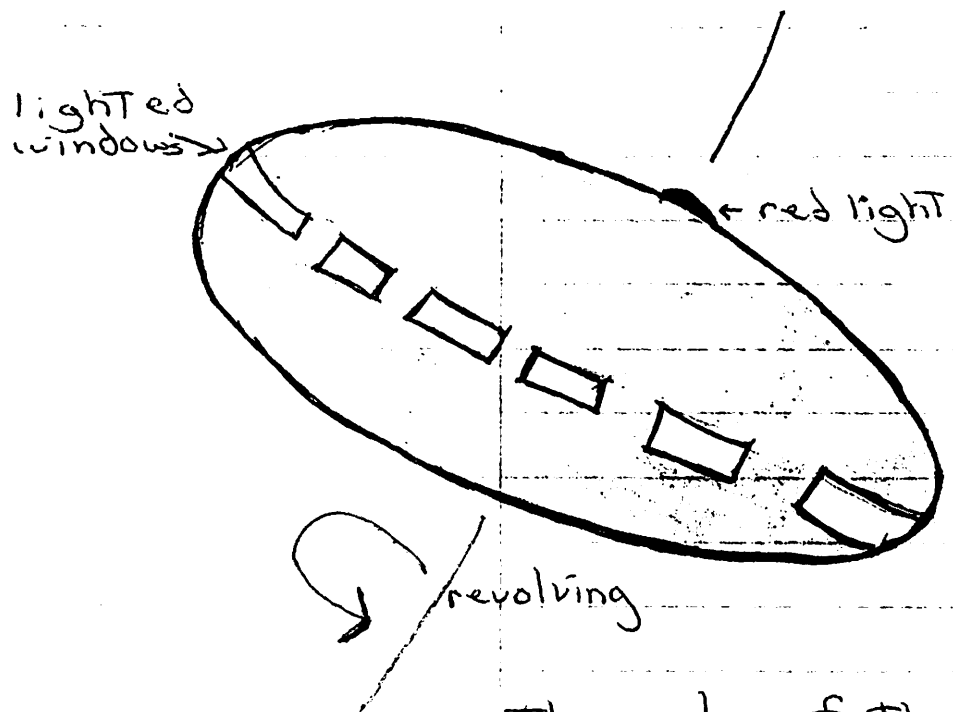

The object definitely appeared to be a solid structure with a dull metallic finish. It had a row of what appeared to be rectangular shaped windows which were lit up. It was revolving in a counter-clockwise direction, at times revolving at different speeds.

We saw the object as it approached us seeming to follow Rt 80 moving East to West. When it got within a few hundred yards we slow down the car almost to a stop. The object also stopped and hovered for a few minutes. It seemed to be observing us as we observed it. After a few minutes it turned and flew off toward the north and out of sight.
