

CEI: hovering shining object
with one extremely strange
element — non-reflection
of its light on the sea.

On January 15th, 1954, Miss Nilce Correa, 15 years old, while walking by the beach of Itanhaém, São Paulo, had her attention called by an object hovering above the ground, fifty meters high (150 feet) on the divisory line of sea and shore. It had no apparent windows, conning tower or any conspicuous protuberance, but it irradiated some sort of dull light which changed from orange to gray (sic). The moon was present and was reflected by the water but the light emitted by the strange body was not reflected. It was bigger than a DC-3 (Dakota), (C-47) and hovered for 15 minutes before speeding noiselessly West. *from The Flying Saucer (Brazil) #2, Oct. 1956. p.5.*

I have not been able to find another reference to this event, but I believe that the case still might be a good one because this was reported by the early outstanding Brazilian group, and occurred in their home town area.
