On January 28<sup>th</sup> at 10 p.m. my sister Diane Olson and I were in my driveway at 192 California Ave. in Provo, Utah. At that time we observed what appeared to be a shooting star. [REDACTED] However we noticed a strange [REDACTED] red light on the end of the object. It then began to dip and shimmer as it traveled in a semi-[REDACTED]<sup>circle</sup> around us and came closer to the earth.

We decided to follow the object and we did this to the end of my street which ends as a slippery port begins. As we came to the end of the road I believed the object was gone. However from my left side I saw the object rising from below the sidewalk. I followed, turning to my left, until the object was alone and to the left of me. At this time we both jumped out of the car. I ran closer to the object which was now partially [REDACTED] over house and [REDACTED] almost over me. It then

we were under the orders  
of your direction to make a flight over

wait around for the perfect light but we  
had a luminous portion of the horizon

see the sun round in shape and  
almost to the middle of a visible  
circle of light.

How good would it be to observe  
such a display as this and its quality?  
Any point concerned to the effect if  
our atmosphere and the best way of  
the effect of the sun if found  
would be followed if the best and  
most direct the best atmospheric  
get in the clouds always difficult  
and most off airily and several  
hundred feet above 30° to 45° above
