According to a report in APRO files:


"In the summer of 1954, I was out on a date with a boyfriend. We were just riding around talking, when I realized it was after 10:00 p.m. and I was suppose to be home at 10:00. We were going in a southerly direction and I lived to the north. Jim said he would turn around as soon as he could. At this time the area we were in was not developed and had few houses or buildings in the area. We had gone a short distance when we saw a drive [road] to our right. As Jim turned into the drive, which was on an upgrade, we were shocked by what we saw. In the air, to our left about 100 feet from us, were two yellow glowing, oval-shaped objects. They were quite close together in a straight line. They were rotating in a circle both in the same direction. Each had a shaft of light coming from the underside and touching the ground. They were hovering above a field next to the drive we were in. They were about 50

feet from the ground and were approximately 6-10 feet long each. I do not remember or could not tell their. On our right was a large house completely dark. Jim started to get out of the car but I was scared and asking him to stay and take me home and then return if he wanted to. He agreed. We quickly turned around and headed north in the direction of my home. About a mile down the road, Jim slammed on the brakes and directly opposite us, over a field, were the same two objects. By this time I was begging to go home, which we did.

"Jim stayed long enough for us to tell my sister and her boyfriend about their experience. (Later he told me he had returned but there was nothing there at all.) My sister and I talked about 15 minutes and then decided to go to bed. In passing the front door, which was opened, we noticed, above the house opposite ours, were two glowing, rotating lights. We ran upstairs and watched the lights for at least 10 or 15 minutes. They were high enough in the air that we could make out any shape. I am still positive they were the same two objects. They were still there when we went to bed.
