

1956: Wickford, UK C21

"Shoot-a-Saucer."

28 December. Wickford, England. (Early morning)

"Fired his shotgun."

According to a London newspaper:

"Maurice Waddope, a former railway fireman, went out early to shoot a sparrowhawk with his A40 Shotgun. Through the mist he saw a circular object overhead (est. 40m alt.) 'six times the size of a penny held at arms length.' Waddope fled to a clearing, loaded and fired his gun. The shot hit against the metal craft, rebounding and hitting him in the chest. The object hovered over the treetops for 4-5 minutes, after which it shot away westward toward London." (118.)
