Dear Sir:

Having recently read your Report on
the U. F. O. and also heard you on the Garry
Moore show - I decided to write and tell
you of an experience I had a year ago
April 1956.

I was asleep at the time and a brilliant
light shining through my windows wakened me. The
whole sky and my bedroom shone with a brilliant
green light. I could see all the trees and houses on
the next street and every object in my room.
The time was 3 o'clock in the morning. I sat up
in bed and suddenly a large global shaped
object hovered over the next street and slowly
settled to about 35 feet from the ground. I believe
it came from the South West as I was facing
the East at the time. The object was a brilliant
green and a red light circled it from top to
bottom, it looked like a large red neon tube
light. While the object hovered there it paled
in color and stayed six or seven minutes. I
tried to call my parents but for the first time in
my life had lost my voice, so just sat and
watched. I judged it to be about forty to fifty
feet in circumference. I was afraid there may
be people in it so did not go near the window.
Suddenly there was a whirring sound and it

began to brighter, then the red tube light began to brighter and grow larger throwing out sparks and a hissing sound could be heard, it suddenly shot straight up in the air and headed in an easterly direction leaving a brilliant tail effect in the sky. By then I found my nerve and ran to my parents, wakened them and pulled up the dark blinds in time for them to see the remaining green sky. I judged it to be travelling at a tremendous speed up to 3000 miles per hour.

I waited up for my cousin-in-law who was expected home from work at 3:30 o'clock. He had seen the object travelling at a great rate of speed and thought it to be a meteor as had the other fellows with him.

The next evening the Toronto Daily Star reported on many people sighting the flying object and the green sky, among them were two policemen - and people on Lake Ontario's shore of New York State and also in Northern Ontario. although no one reported seeing it hovering around as I had.

Burlington is on Lake Ontario - Western end, 10 miles East of Hamilton and 45 miles West of Toronto, Ontario.

This and another letter I have written today are the only reports I have made, although I have told most all my friends. Hoping this may help in your work.
